## How can I use this with my children?

## How does this help my children's learning?

Empathy is important, as it helps build and cement our relationships. Empathy is caring how others feel and being able to express that. This activity helps children to better understand empathy.

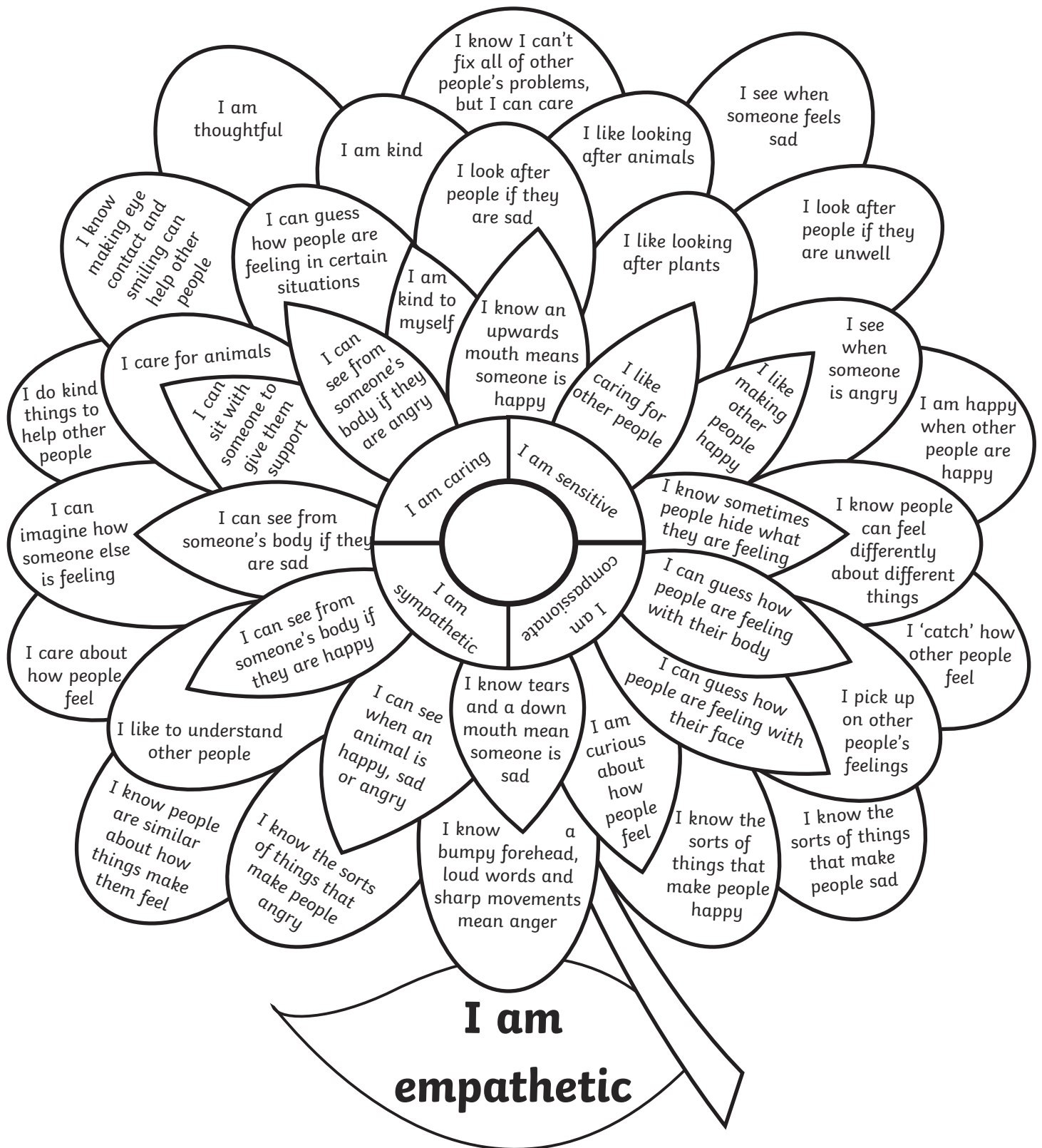
