




I can explain the main stages of plant reproduction







Different plants vary in how much of these things they need. For example, cacti can survive in areas with little water, whereas water lilies need to live in water.

Key Words	Meaning
Fertiliser	A chemical or natural substance (like cow poo!) added to soil to help plants grow.
Nutrients	We get nutrients from food. A plant makes its own food so creates its own nutrients.
Pollination	Pollination is the transfer of pollen from a male part of a plant to a female part of a plant. This is how many plants reproduce.
Support	To hold something up.
Reproduction	When more plants are made, it is called reproduction
Seed disper- sal	When a seed moves away from a parent plant.
Seed for- mation	This is the when the seed is made at the end of the plant reproduction process.
