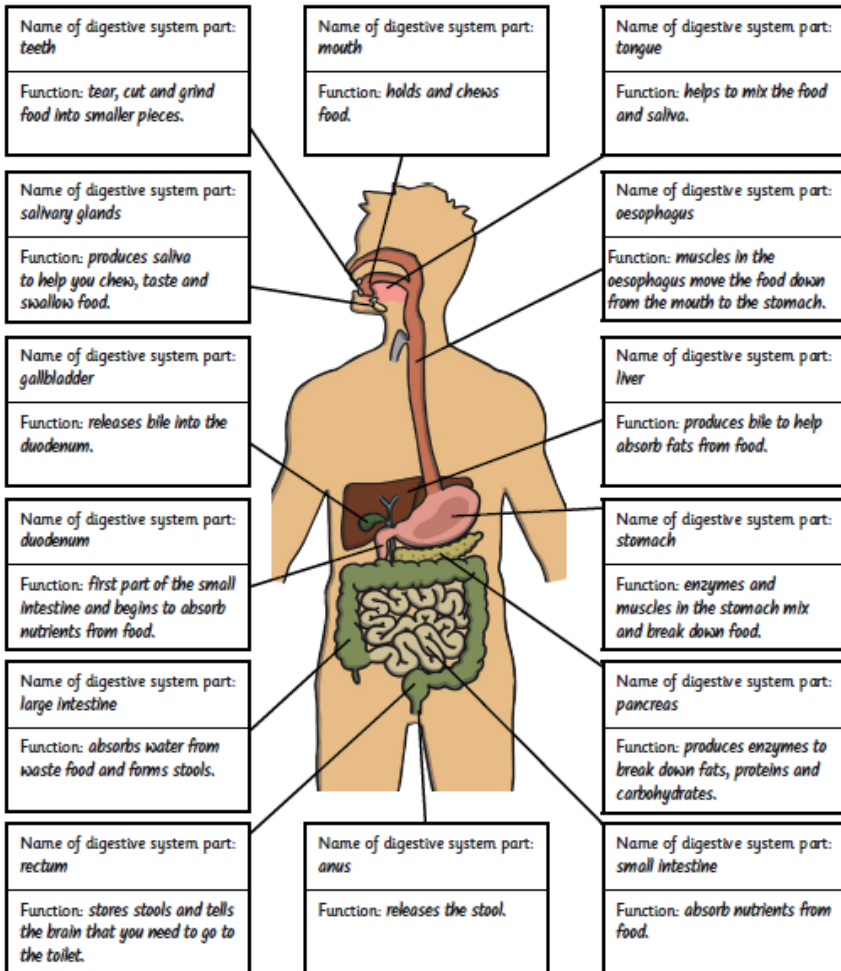


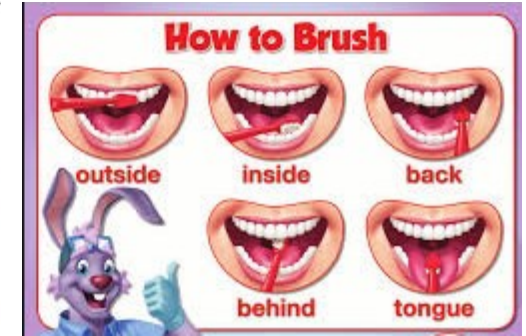
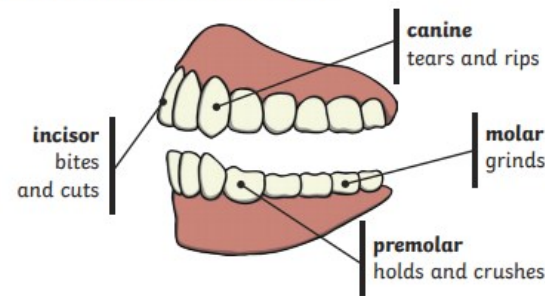

Human Teeth and Their Functions



My teeth are used to help me chew my food. If I don't look after them properly, they will decay and I will lose them. I need to brush my teeth twice a day to help keep them healthy.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Digestion	The process of digesting food
Saliva	Saliva is mostly made of water and it helps you to chew, taste and swallow food.
Oesophagus	A muscular tube which moves food from the mouth to the stomach
Enzyme	Special molecules in the body (molecules make up cells, which make up tissue, glands, organs, etc). They act to create a chemical reaction. In the digestive system the reaction they produce breaks down food.
Bile	Helps to break food down
Gastric juices	An acidic fluid that helps to promote digestion
Pancreatic juices	The clear fluid secreted by the pancreas during digestion
